Requested: Approval to Proceed with Project


Background:

The College of Engineering intends to create a new administrative office suite in the Chrysler Center, which is located between Pierpont Commons and the Media Union on North Campus. The goal is to co-locate several staff members who handle corporate and government relations for the College thereby achieving greater efficiency in these areas of activity. The renovation of room 143 will provide space for seven staff members as well as workplaces for corporate visitors. The project will renovate 1,900 sq. ft. and include new furniture and all architectural, electrical and mechanical modification to the space.

We propose to use TMP Associates, Inc. as the firm to design the project. We expect to issue the project for bids this Fall and complete construction in Spring 2001. The project is estimated to cost \$525,000, plus funding for furnishings, with the money provided from the College of Engineering and gift funds.

We recommend the Regents approve the Chrysler Center for Continuing Engineering Education Renovation of Room 143 project as described.
