Background:

The Division of Kinesiology has expanded their research program and requires additional laboratory space for Molecular Kinesiology, Exercise Endocrinology and Substrate Metabolism in the Central Campus Recreation Building (CCRB). The project would include relocating Kinesiology programs currently located in CCRB lower level to the eleventh floor of 300 North Ingalls Building and converting two dry labs to wet laboratory space in the CCRB.

Approximately 3,200 gross square feet of space would be renovated for laboratory, office, student work space, and storage. Mechanical, electrical, casework, and interior finishes would be included in the project.

The project is estimated to cost \$850,000 with funding from central administration. Ann Arbor Architects Collaborative will design the project. Construction is scheduled to begin in Fall 2000, with construction complete in Spring 2001.

We recommend that the Regents approve the project as described and authorize issuing the project for bids and awarding a construction contract providing that bids are within the approved budget.
