Subject: Parking Services
Year 2000 Annual Maintenance Program

Action Requested: Approval to Proceed with Project

Background:

The Parking Services annual safety, maintenance, and repairs program for year 2000 is comprised of several major projects, plus minor improvements to several smaller parking lots, annual maintenance to parking decks, and lighting and landscaping improvements. Major projects include the resurfacing of the School of Music surface lot; repairing pavement at several loading and service areas; paving the Wall Street parking lot; and rebuilding and repaving parking lots at G. G. Brown and Space Research.

This program is estimated to cost \$3,300,000, with funding provided from Parking Services revenues. The construction is scheduled to coincide with the summer paving season. The projects will be designed by the University of Michigan Facilities Planning and Design Department.

We recommend the Regents approve proceeding with the Parking Services Year 2000 Annual Maintenance Program as described.
