

Requirements for Coming to U-M Campuses

We hope that this message finds you safe and healthy. As you probably know, the fall semester has begun, and many students, along with many AEC employees, are on campus now, while other students and employees continue to learn or work remotely.

The University of Michigan campuses look and feel different this fall. Our division has participated in many initiatives to prepare for the fall semester and we are adapting to President Schlissel's mandate requiring the wearing of face coverings on our campuses.

If you plan to come to the University, you must follow these basic public health measures each time you visit campus to ensure your safety and the safety of the University community:

- 1. Don't come on campus if you are sick.
- 2. Meet with AEC and other project team members remotely when practical.
- 3. Complete the ResponsiBLUE screening check before entering U-M campuses.
- 4. Complete required contractor's screening checks on construction sites, even if you have already completed the ResponsiBLUE screening.
- 5. Wear face coverings at all times when on campus, both indoors and outside, including on construction sites.
- 6. Maintain physical distance of 6 feet.
